Assist as a mentor, teacher and caretaker at this sea-town village orphanage, bringing smiles to its children along the way!

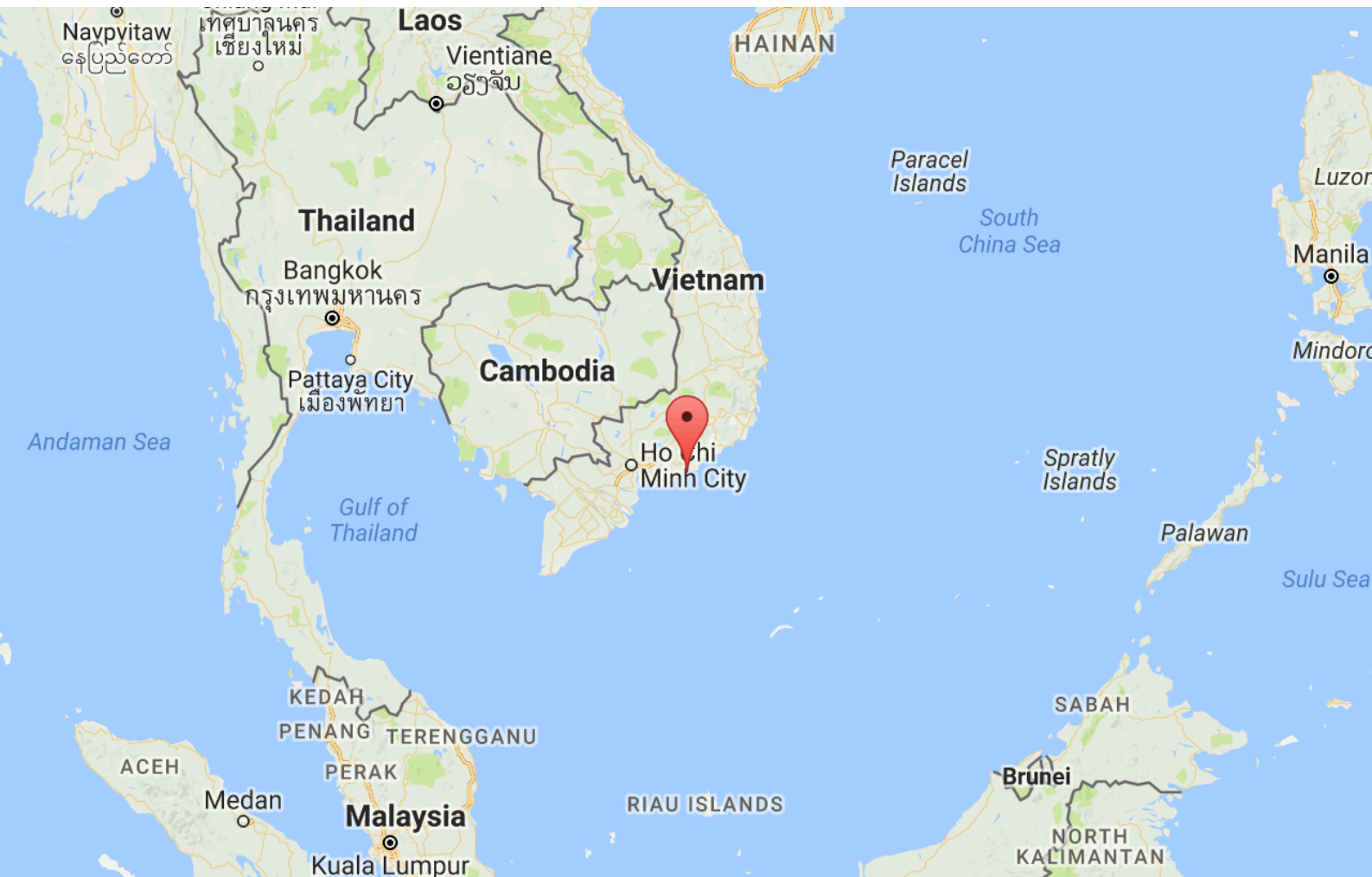

Program Description

Experience Vietnam by taking care of children at a local boarding home. You will be looking after them and giving them the assistance they need in their daily tasks.

There are around 20 children in this small orphanage, many of the children are still infants and in need of a lot of care and attention. Some children from higher age groups (up to 18 years of age) will need your help with homework as well as someone to teach them some basic social skills and life skills.

The level of English possessed by these children is also very low, so one of our focuses is to teach them this important language so they may possess this useful skill. You should focus on the fundamentals, such as simple vocabulary, basic conversation and writing.

You'll help the orphanage teach the children other life skills as well, such as those that promote creativity and artistic skills. The children receive piano lessons for example, as well as art lessons in which they create embroidered images that later on get sold in order to raise funds for the orphanage!

- Create opportunities to mentor and relate to the local Vietnamese children
- Assist the orphanage with extra hands
- Provide you with teaching and childcare experience

Schedule

Monday

On your first day you will be introduced to the orphanage and staff you'll be working with. Then, after a full brief of the program, you will learn what is expected of you for the week and then be ready to take part!

Tuesday to Friday

Throughout the day, you will help in the caretaking, teaching basic English, creating activities/games and conversing with the children in the orphanage.

You can expect 4-5 hours of work throughout the day.

This schedule can be changed and/or amended depending on weather conditions, local conditions and unforeseen circumstances.

This program may incur small travel costs (no more than 1 euro per day) for travel between project sites
