


Improve homes and community buildings in the La Gi fishing village through light construction work.

This is where we saw a way to help!

Through renovation and light construction work from people such as yourself, we can assist the community while allowing you to engage with the local people and environment while learning more about the local culture.

Work can include housing renovation and light construction such as painting. Typical tasks could be repairing chairs, tables, toilets, building walls etc. Tasks will depend on local conditions and what is needed at the time. You can expect to be working 4-5 hours a day.
