Program Description

After your introduction week, you will work as an assistant teacher at one of our many Kindergarten schools in Goa. This program helps children in the villages to improve their English language. You will primarily teach children English. They may be called upon to help teach drama, music and foreign languages. You will assist other teachers and staff and may have to create teaching plans, etc.

All the teaching institutions are over 5 years old. They all share the common values and aim to create a better future for the children. Some of them provide free education to the children. All the organizations are well managed and are supervised by officers from government and private organizations.
